In coordination with PACIFIC STANDARD TIME, the Chouinard Foundation (
www.chouinardfoundation.org) presents a massive, interactive online library covering the Chouinard
Foundation's efforts over the last 12 years - dedicated to strengthening the legacy of the original Chouinard
Art Institute, 1921-1972 - one of the most renowned art schools in history.

Many artists celebrated in PACIFIC STANDARD TIME were either Chouinard students, teachers or both. - -The Chouinard House and the founding of the Chouinard Foundation by Robert Perine and Dave Tourje in 1999.
- -How and why the Chouinard Art Institute was shut down in 1972 and merged into Cal Arts.
- -The Siqueiros Mural Discovery, "Street Meeting", with the Emmy-nominated KCET documentary and other press.
- -All the L.A. Times articles chronicling the Chouinard Foundation's history written by Suzanne Muchnic and other notable writers.
